Ex quibus facile potest constare, ita eum humanis interfuisse, ut novissima cogitaret. Morbum ejus quod attinet, non ita pridem 26. Augusti ipsum Ciz in statione sua, id est, cum Advo-  
catum ageret, paroxysmus febrilis in-  
cessit: Ac principio quidem operâ Medici usus meliusculè habuit, & propterea laboribus suis iterum defungi voluit. Sed enim calor preternaturalis recidivam innovans, coëgit ipsum ab expeditione desistere. Qua de  
causa Lipsiam vectus, Medicos experientissimos in consilium adhibuit. Et quidem febris initio haud ita minax apparebat, sed mox in continuam putridam degeneravit; cui tandem lethargus supervenit. Ita factum,  
ut vires, laboribus vocationis & ex filii carissimi morte residuo squalore non parùm debilitate, magis magisq; imminuerentur. Quemadmodum vero alias semper, ita quoq; in hoc morbo totum se Deo suo resignavit, & in  
eius voluntate, quemcunq; exitum daturus esset, paratissimo animo acquicvit, fretus, si migrandum hinc esset, divinâ promissione de occupando in alterâ vitâ tabernaculo fiducia & quietis opulentæ: quam sibi ab Ec-  
clesiaste ex Esaiâ c. 32. v. 18. solatii ergò propositam, supremis suis sermonibus aliquoties iteravit, tandemq; inter astantium preces Salvatori suo animam, die nupero Solis in ipso noctis concubio, circiter dividiam duodeci-
